DigCompAE

The DigCompAE project, funded via the Erasmus+ programme of the EU, aims to integrate DigComp, the European digital skills framework, into adult education. In 2023-2026 it develops tools and training opportunities for educators, and promotes transnational exchange of experience. The project aims to contribute to the sustainable adoption of DigComp in education systems across Europe.

Objectives

- Integrating DigComp into the work of adult education organisations to promote learners' digital skills
- Exchange of experience between organisations at the European level
- Create resources such as case studies and tools to help incorporate DigComp into adult education
- Encourage and enable other European educators to adopt these practices

Work packages

- Research on existing good practice
- Developing workshop concepts for educators
- Training of adult education employees
- Making DigComp an integral part of everyday work processes in the participating organisations
- Dissemination of the results



What is DigComp?

DigComp is the *Digital Competence Framework for Citizens*. This is a system to describe the various skills citizens need to participate adequately in modern society, related to digital technology, e.g. when using a computer or a smartphone.
